



The Bachelor of Interior Design is a four-year undergraduate program. It typically takes a full-time student taking 15 credits per term, 12 terms to complete the program. The unique nature of four starts per year allows students to complete in 12 terms, or as little as 3 years, providing no study breaks and successful completion of courses.

The following data was collected using institutional records and an alumni survey that was administered 6 months after graduation. 29 out of 50 alumni responded to the survey.

### **Student Attrition and Retention**

52% of the students admitted in 2022 returned in 2023, putting attrition at 48%.

### **Graduation Rates**

Of the students graduating in 2022, 25% graduated or are still active; 12% completed in 4 years or less. 13% completed in 5 years or are still active in the program.

### **Acceptance into Graduate Programs**

There were no applicants to graduate schools from the graduating class of 2022.

### **Job Placement Rates**

96% of the students who graduated in 2022 are employed in interior design or related profession.
